Since the close of the Second Vatican Council in 1965 the term “full, active conscious participation” in the liturgy has been misunderstood. The term does not originate with the Second Vatican Council. Pope Pius X coined the term in his 1903 Motu proprio *tra le sollicitudini*, which concerned the renewal of sacred music. In the writing of Pope Pius X the phrase “full active participation” meant the active passivity of the faithful offering themselves in prayer during the celebration of the liturgy. In *Sacrosanctum concillium*, the decree on the liturgy of the Second Vatican Council, uses the term in the same way. This interpretation is reinforced by an *ad limina* speech that Pope John Paul II gave to the bishops of the Northwestern region of the United States (Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, and Alaska) in 1998. I have included this speech in this week’s bulletin. I encourage each person to read it and reflect upon it.

The Church is in a time when the faithful have to be united in the proper celebration of the Sacred Ministries. Through the reverent celebration of the Mass we, as Christians, participate in the sanctification of our souls and the sanctification of the world. Liturgy is the center of our lives as Christians, so we have an obligation to celebrate the liturgy well and with the reverence that God deserves.

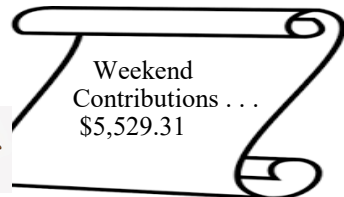
