- 4) A typed letter of no more than 2 pages by applicant that includes the following:
  - Parish involvement-the past three (3) years only. List parish activities and in what capacity you were involved ( i.e., leader, teacher, usher, Eucharistic minister). May include, but is not limited to classes, faith group participation or leadership, service and other parish activities.
  - Community Involvement
  - Academic goals and interests. What do you plan to study and why?
